

CANE Educational Grants

Grants of up to \$500 each are available for teacher use for themselves and/or their students for the following projects focusing on classical antiquity and its modern legacy:

1. Research or creative projects both in and out of the classroom;
2. Materials, such as classroom reading materials, visual aids, and games, to further teaching and learning;
3. Programs which promote experiential learning, such as workshops and museum visits.

Applications are invited from educators at all levels who are members of CANE in good standing. Preference will be given to educators working at the pre-collegiate levels and to people who have not recently received funds from CANE.

Applications may be submitted at any time and will be reviewed by the committee on a rolling basis.

Grant recipients must submit a brief account detailing the results of their projects. This account may be featured in CANE publications and communications with membership.
