

CANE Educational Programs Discretionary Grants

For Teachers and Classical Organizations

Members of CANE are invited to apply for modest funds to support educational programs which promote the study of classical languages and ancient history. In the past, funds have been used by individuals as well as by state and local classical organizations to support such events as annual meetings, workshops, and museum visits. Applicants for funds to support educational programs should include the following information:

- Name and contact information
- A brief description of your organization (if applicable)
- A statement indicating the educational objectives or desired outcomes of the program or event, a description of the intended audience, and the desired amount.

Applications for grants are accepted throughout the year on a rolling basis. A majority of grants support events and programs from \$200-250 (although grants of up to \$500 will be considered). To apply, please contact the CANE Coordinator of Educational Programs (eduprograms@caneweb.org).
