

Application for the Classical Association of New England's  
Teacher Enrichment Scholarship

**The CANE Teacher Enrichment Scholarship is an award of up to \$1500 for tuition reimbursement for current or retired teachers who are members of CANE to enroll in a Classics course for personal enrichment.**

**Eligibility and Requirements:**

1. All applicants must have been members of CANE in good standing for at least two full and consecutive years immediately prior to the year in which they apply for the award.
2. Courses should not be part of a formal degree program or certification, but simply for personal enrichment.
3. Priority will be given to applications from current or retired Latin or Greek teachers of secondary school, public or private, who teach within the geographical boundaries of CANE.
4. Examples of courses may be a spoken Latin course, a course in a specific author the teacher has not studied before, or a beginning Greek course.
