CANE Endowment Scholarship

for summer travel for teachers and graduate students

The CANE Endowment Scholarship is an award of up to approximately \$5100 for summer study normally at the American School of Classical Studies at Athens or at places other than the American Academy in Rome.

Eligibility and Requirements:

1. All applicants must be current members of CANE in good standing to apply for the award.
2. Priority will be given to applications from Latin teachers of secondary school, public or private, who teach within the geographical boundaries of CANE, but graduate students within the geographical boundaries of CANE may also apply.
3. It is understood that applicants will not be applying for the Endowment Scholarship and the Coulter Rome Scholarship in the same year.
4. Scholarship recipients are requested to file a written report with the Chairperson of the Scholarship Committee at the end of their study period.
5. Travel is expected to be completed during the year funds are awarded, otherwise funds must be returned to CANE in full.
