

Renata Poggioli Award

for summer travel to Italy or Greece

Available only in even years, the Poggioli Award, established by the Boston Fund in 1991, funds study and/or travel in Italy and/or Greece typically during the summer months. The CANE Scholarship Committee makes the Award, generally between \$4000-\$6000, every other year.

Eligibility and Requirements:

- 1. You must be teaching in New England at the secondary or college level.
- 2. You must have a rank no higher than untenured assistant professor, or have taught less than ten years at the secondary level.
- 3. You must have no access to major university research-grant and travel-grant programs.

The recipient of the Poggioli Award need not be a member of CANE, but CANE will ask for a written report at the conclusion of the program. Travel is expected to be completed during the year funds are awarded, otherwise funds must be returned to CANE in full.
