## THE CLASSICAL ASSOCIATION OF NEW ENGLAND RETIREES FOR EDUCATION (CANE CARE) IS PLEASED TO ANNOUNCE ITS FOURTH ANNUAL STUDENT LATIN MOTTO PRIZE CONTEST

Student Goal: Create a personal motto in Latin that best expresses the nature of the social, moral, and/or spiritual identity to which the student aspires.

To be eligible, the student must:

- have <u>completed</u> one year of Latin study at the high school or middle school level.
- be in a full year Latin course during the 2025-2026 school year.
- be at a parochial, private, public, or home school in one of the six New England states for the 2025-2026 school year.
- honorably create the motto from an entirely personal perspective.
- accept in person, if possible, any winning prize at the Annual CANE Meeting at Brandeis
  University on Friday 20 March 2026. If the student is unable to attend the Brandeis meeting,
  a designated adult (e.g., the student's teacher or relation) must be willing to accept the
  winner's award at Brandeis.

Students who enter the contest may not use Latin or English quotations from literary or other sources. Students may seek the advice of their classroom teachers only as much as that advice pertains to the accuracy of the Latin, NOT for suggestions as to the content of the motto. Teachers must also refrain from helping the student to craft the Latin. No motto may exceed twelve (12) Latin words.

There will be FOUR (4) prizes awarded by a panel of judges, retired Latin teacher members of CANE CARE. Each prize will be a \$50.00 gift certificate to Barnes and Noble for use at a local Barnes and Noble store, or at the Barnes and Noble online site. All participants will receive an online certificate of contest entry from CANE CARE which they may use for such purposes as college resumes.
